

Marine Irish Data Atlas - CMRC


- Rich source of Marine and Coastal information

 - 115 data layers / 76 downloadable
- Metadata, data and information held centrally
- Ongoing maintenance of content required
- Funding from NDP and NI EHS


INFOMAR – Seabed Survey



SeaChange Strategy 2013 Objectives


- Develop a National Coastal and Marine Information Service

 - emerging technologies that will support knowledge and information management objectives in the marine sector
- Promote an effective marine knowledge infrastructure and policy at a national level
- 3. Ensure a high profile for marine data sets when data and information policy and legislation are being framed at national and international levels



- A component of Ireland's SDI?








InterRisk

- Services reused by multiple clients / portals




