## **UCGIS HUD Symposium Rescheduled**

The second symposium for the Urban Indicators Grant was to be held in Washington DC in late September. Due to the tragic events of September 11<sup>th</sup>, the symposium was postponed until January 9-11, 2002. The symposium will be held in New York City.
